Driver's License Renewals

Driver's license renewals have been going great at the Pine Island License Bureau. Similar to title transfers no license renewal will be processed after 4:00 PM at the direction of the State department of vehicle services.



Preventing Frozen Pipes



- Keep garage doors closed if there are water supply lines in the garage.
- Open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to allow warmer air to circulate around the plumbing. Be sure to move any harmful cleaners and household chemicals up out of the reach of children.
- When the weather is very cold outside, let the cold-water drip from the faucet served by exposed pipes. Running water through the pipe - even at a trickle - helps prevent pipes from freezing.
- If you will be going away during cold weather, leave the heat on in your home, set to a temperature no lower than 55° F.
- If your pipes do freeze shut off the water immediately.
- Be careful turning water back on. Once pipes are thawed, slowly turn the water back on and check pipes and joints for any cracks.

The Pine Island City Council held meetings on Tuesday October 15th & November 19th.

- In October council approved resolution 24-41 to accept the resignation of Council Member Jason Johnson. Council Member Johnson moved outside of city limits and could no longer serve on city council. We want to thank him for his years of service to the city!
- In October council approved the city's 2045 comprehensive plan! A Comprehensive Plan is a city's overall, long-term vision for the future.
- In October council approved the lease to purchase of a new street sweeper.
- In both October and November, council discussed the future of cannabis businesses in Pine Island.
- In November council approved the purchase of new banners for the Main St light posts.
- In November council approved the purchase of new river monitors to assist with future flood mitigation efforts.

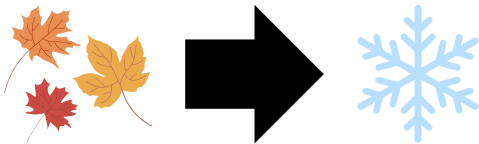

Economic Development (EDA)

The Pine Island Economic Development Authority (EDA) has submitted a grant application to the T-Mobile Hometown Grant program. Winter Parking Reminder



Pine Island City Code SEC. 9.09. SNOW REMOVAL

“It is unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on any street after a snowfall during which there has been any accumulation of snow on any street, and until all snow, ice and similar debris has been plowed or removed from the paved portion of the street”.

In short all vehicles must be removed from the street until all snow and ice have been plowed!
